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Chapter One

MIRACLE INSIDE OF YOU

The title might sound a little bit confusing but its all about the Holy spirit and the fact that he is alive on the inside of us, its a miracle by it self, we must acknowledge him, receive him, surrender to him and He must be a reality to us. We are more than conquerors through the Holy Spirit, but many Spirit-filled Christians are down and out because they do not know the reality of Him. It is sad to have the precious Holy Spirit dwelling on the inside and only recognize Him, once in a while or not at all, most of us we give over to our own feelings and actions, and we think that is the anointing when it is really self and the human spirit. The Holy Spirit is different from the human spirit, so we must learn to separate the two and know when self is taking over. We must know when we are not yielding completely to the Holy Spirit; the Holy Spirit is 100 percent divine; there is no human spirit in Him. He did not come on Earth as a man and take on a body of clay as Jesus did, so the only body the Holy Spirit has to use is yours and mine. He wants to use our hands, our eyes and our tongues. He could have come down here in some kind of physical form and accomplished His work on His own, but the Lord planned for our bodies to be the temples of the Holy Spirit. He planned for the Holy Spirit to set up His office in us and do business with us and for us, so He could bless others through us. The Holy Spirit's strength, wisdom and knowledge come from On High, all of that is available for us, but we cannot use things that we do not know about or recognize; and if we only recognize the Spirit at times, our life will not be as fruitful as God planned it to be.

When you don't know the Holy Spirit, it is also easy to give over to the wrong spirit; and it will not even bother you. Both the Holy Spirit and the devil's spirit are stronger than the human spirit; so if you don't surrender to the Holy Spirit, the devil's spirit will begin to influence you in little ways and then later, in big ways. That is why it is so essential for us to recognize and surrender to the drawing of the Spirit.

The holy spirit is described as the Heavenly Dove. When Jesus was baptized in the Holy Spirit, John saw the Spirit descend on Him in the form of a dove. *In the Book of "Matthew 3:16"* the scripture says And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and behold, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him.

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A dove is a meek and humble bird, and it does not fight and make loud noises like some other birds do. It makes a beautiful coo and has a gentle spirit just like that of the Holy Spirit, In the Bible days, the dove was considered to be a clean bird; so it was used in sacrificial offerings, and the Lord accepted it. God then used the dove as a symbol of the Holy Spirit and of peace, and anyone who has the real Holy Spirit and yields to that Spirit of God has peace and serves it to others, when a person is described as being like a dove, he is gentle, innocent and beloved; and those who are completely yielded to the Holy Spirit are gentle and kind. They are innocent before God because they have been washed in the divine blood, and they speak with innocence because they are filled with the Holy Spirit and no longer a part of this sinful world. They are so loved by the Father because they are just like His beloved Son was when He walked on Earth so many years ago, I love the humility and the tender care of the holy Dove, and He descends on people with gentleness and wondrous, heavenly grace. He is a mighty revelation within of God's grace for us daily through Jesus Christ, and that is why Jesus should be real to everyone who has the Holy Spirit, you cannot have the Holy Spirit without having heavenly love, heavenly grace, heavenly peace and heavenly joy. When He lives within people, He possesses them with so much love that at times they almost feel as if they are going to explode. Then praises roll forth from them because they cannot possibly keep all of that love bottled up inside. God sent the Holy spirit on Earth to lead us, direct us, advise us and show us which way to go. He will influence our course of action and help us make decisions.he is indeed our helper The Holy spirit will help you more than any human being ever could, and He will only guide you into truth because He is the Spirit of truth. Jesus said, in the Book of "John 16:13" However, when he, the Spirit of truth, has come, he will guide you into all truth; for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak; and he will tell you things to come. Wow!!

When you have the Holy Spirit you have all truth; so you should never have any doubt in you because there is no room for any error. In the Spirit "1 John 4:6" the scripture says We are of God, he who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. My Brothers and Sisters! We cannot mix the truth with anything or go by our opinions. We have to die to our opinions then he will guide us into the same paths that Jesus walked and show us the footprints of our Master. Then He will magnify those footprints so we will have no trouble walking in them. Through the Holy Spirit, we will become a part of Jesus; and we will operate like He did when He was here. Then every step we take will move us closer to Heaven.

Jesus continued in the Book of "John 14:16" saying that And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever. When troubles come, the flutter of the Spirit within your bosom will let you know He is working; and you will feel His comfort. When your heart is about to break, you will feel His love, His help, His touch, His grace and His understanding. Remember that He is alive on the inside of us, and I am saying this again the Holy Spirit must be a reality to us so He can give us the strength to unload our burdens at the feet of Jesus Christ.

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In the same passage verse 26 Jesus said, But the Comforter, "which is the Holy Spirit", whom the Father will send in my name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. We don't have an idea at all of all the knowledge that is available to us through the One who has come to live in us as our helper. We cannot just read or hear that the Holy Spirit is our Teacher; we must take great pride and strength in knowing He is and in knowing we have Him. He has come to serve us, so we can serve the Lord in every way God wants us to, without the Holy Spirit and without knowing Him, we are not going to be able to serve the Lord in all capacities and do all that He wants of us. To have the Holy Spirit's help, we must yield to Him and live in the Word, the truth. Only with the Word in your heart will the Holy Spirit have something to work with. The scripture says in "Il Timothy 2:15" be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. The Word will shine its light on your every path, the Word must be like food to us. We must eat it and digest it. In "Jeremiah 15:16" the scripture says, your words were found, and I did eat them; and your word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of my heart. It is so wonderful to study word after word and draw from the Gospel well of salvation. The Word cleanses as well, we read this in "Psalms 119:9" and it says, Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to thy word. Again in the Book of "Ephesians 5:26" and it says, That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word. We indeed must take heed to the Word of the living God, or else will go to hell. If you don't understand the Bible, remember that the Holy Spirit is our great Teacher, we must study the Bible with the help of the Holy Spirit because He is our Teacher. He will guide us through the Scriptures and feed us only truth. He will serve us the Word, explain it to us and make it as simple as A-B-C or 1-2-3. Then we will not struggle in the dark saying, "I don't understand." He will teach us more than any teacher, professor or instructor on Earth; and He will give us more wisdom and knowledge than we could ever get from any person or worldly institution. We can have everything we need in living reality today through the Holy Spirit.

He will also teach us how to pray, and He helps us to get our prayers through. He anoints us to talk to the Father, to listen to Him and to reason with Him. He will even pray through us, but we have to let Him say what He wants to say and not what we want to say. He will teach us to pray in God's will only, but we have to really mean it and want the will of God in everything. We might be confused sometimes but the Holy Spirit knows everything and He makes intercession for us. In the Book of "Romans 8:26" the scripture says, Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. These are the groanings of the Holy Spirit. We cannot utter them because they are so far beyond us, so deep and so profound; and they come from deep within our innermost being. They are not part of the human nature; they are the nature of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Nobody can understand the Spirit's groanings, but they bring the answers we need because the Spirit only makes intercession for you according to the will of God.

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In the same Chapter verse 27, it says, Now he who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because he makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God. Jesus also makes intersession for us. "Romans 8:34" says Who is he that condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us. Two members of the Godhead make intercession for us, so we can get our prayers answered; Hallelujah!! when you are led by the Holy Spirit, you will have faith in what God's miracle power can do; and you will be ready to make intercessory prayer for our beloved ones and for your brothers and sisters in Christ who may need our help. When we pray the right way, our prayers can't be snatched by anyone, when you are led by the Holy Spirit, you will ask the right things of the Lord because you will have the mind of the Spirit, People who pray selfish prayers will not get answers. In the Book of "James 4:3" it says, you ask, and receive not, because you ask amiss, that you may consume it upon your lusts. When people pray for the wrong things, their prayers are lifeless. That is why our praying???? Has to be done through the Holy Spirit, dead prayers never reach the throne of grace. That is why there are so many spiritually dead churches, and their church members are not ready to meet the Lord, the people are not being led or taught by the Spirit, and they don't live in the Spirit, but again I say, you have to pray according to the will of God, when you always want the will of God, then all things will work for good. "Romans 8:28" says And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to his purpose. The Lord has a purpose in each person's calling, and He has called us unto Himself because He has a plan for each life.

It is about time to tell the world who the Holy Spirit is, why He came from Heaven and why it is so important for us to receive Him. The Father Himself said He is as important as Jesus was when He was here preaching and teaching the word of God, but The world does not see Him or know Him. However, we must be baptized in the Holy Spirit, accept him and get to know Him. Jesus said, But ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. we will never be able to function as we should without the guidance of the Holy Spirit. That is why He is always seeking to take you in the direction of truth, righteousness and grace, when Jesus was baptized in the Holy Spirit, God said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased God was not just pleased; He was well-pleased. The Bible also tells us that Enoch pleased God, "Hebrew 11:5" says By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death; and was not found, because God had taken him: for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. The Lord is going to be wellpleased with us too in this final hour, because through the Holy Spirit we will walk like our Master, talk like our Master, love like our Master and serve like our Master, Jesus Christ.

Remember that Jesus said the Holy Spirit would be our comforter. I've explained earlier, but do we let Him comfort us? The scripture says in the Book of "John 16:7" Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. The Holy Spirit must be everything to us, and we have to give our life completely to Him, we can't do much without our Comforter, even Jesus was the Son of God, but He had to receive the Spirit when He was here. John saw that take place; and he said, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. "John 1:32", Then Jesus was led by the Spirit. And Jesus being full of the Holy Spirit returned from Jordan "where He had been baptized", and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness "to fast". "Luke 4:1" The devil tempted Jesus during His time in the wilderness; but when the fast was over, Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee. "Luke 4:14" the Holy Spirit has come to live in us and stay with us until we go to Heaven because we need Him, he is the one who's holding back the forces of the enemy so that we can not be harmed, the Holy Spirit has come to do so many things for us, for He is the knowledge of God's wisdom, the grace of God's thoughts and our divine intelligence, the Holy Spirit teaches us to live as holy as God lives. The Bible says, I Peter 1:16, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

When you are born again, the heavy burden of sin is lifted from you; and you are made a new person who is pure, clean and holy. Salvation is such a great feeling that you may think it is the end when it is really just the beginning. You have to go on to receive the Holy Spirit, Being baptized in the Spirit is an experience you will never forget for all eternity. When you are baptized, the Holy Spirit will give you such freedom and jubilation that you can again think you have it all; but it is just the beginning of a new life in the Spirit, when the Holy Spirit comes into your life, He comes to stay; and He will not move out unless you reject??? Salvation and the Holy Spirit baptism are the two experiences the Lord uses to usher us into a place where we live and walk in the Spirit. "Galatians 5:25" says If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Being taught by the Spirit and led by the Spirit is the only life to live here on Earth. It is a heavenly life that you must strive to keep every day.

The scripture is clear in "Romans 8:14" and it says. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. To be a son or a daughter of God, you have to be led by the Holy Spirit, you know, you are so special in God's eyes, and your life is so precious even billionaires can't afford it, make up your mind now, If you want to be a member of the Holy Spirit's family, get to know the Holy Spirit, you must first get right with God.

Say this prayer with me right now. Oh, God, save my soul! I have sinned against you, and I am unclean and unfit for Heaven. I don't want to go to hell. Jesus, I know you died for me, and I know there is power in your blood to wash away all of my sins! Come into my heart, Jesus! Come on in! If you meant that prayer, Jesus has come; and He is yours. Now, you can have the good Holy Spirit and be healed. Let the fire of the Spirit fall, and let the Lord baptize you and heal you at the same time. In the mighty and matchless name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen



Chapter Two

THE FRUIT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The nine fruits of the Holy Spirit are, "Love", "Joy", "Peace", "Longsuffering", "Kindness", "Goodness", "Faithfulness", "Gentleness", "Selfcontrol". The Holy Spirit brought the nine divine fruits of the Spirit, there are no human weaknesses in those fruits; they are filled with divine strength, and they are all available to us, so are you active Spiritually? The only way we can know if the Holy Spirit is working in our life is by verifying if we are operating in those fruits listed above, and the list is found in "Galatians 5:22-23". The Holy Spirit serves us these divine fruits, they are not produced in Heaven; they are produced inside of us, through the blood of Jesus christ. The word "fruit" refers to the natural product of a living thing, Paul used "fruit" to help us understand the product of the Holy Spirit, who lives inside every believer. Fruit of the Spirit is produced by the Spirit,so as we grow, all the characteristics of Christ will be manifested in our lives, but just like physical fruit needs time to grow, the fruits of the Spirit will not ripen in our lives overnight. Like a successful gardener must battle against weeds to enjoy the sweet fruit they desire, we must constantly fight the "weeds" of our old sinful nature that want to choke out the work of the Spirit.

The Holy Spirit gives us the power we need to reject those old sinful desires, as we give the Spirit more control of our lives, he begins to work through us by shaping us more and more, God's goal is for us to be like Jesus, we can't be held down the Bible says clearly in "2 Corinthians 17-18" says Now, the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is present, there is freedom, all of us, then, reflect the glory of the Lord with uncovered faces; and that same glory, coming from the Lord, who is the Spirit, transforms us into his likeness in an ever greater degree of glory. In "Romans 8:29" says for whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. so the Holy Spirit is constantly at work to get rid of our sinful ways, "Galatians 5:19" says now the works of the flesh are evident, which are; adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness. This is contrary to what the Holy Spirit what to display, the Holy Spirit wants to display His fruit instead.

Therefore, the presence of the "fruit of the Spirit" is evidence that our character is becoming more like Jesus Christ, but some of us do not even recognize His fruits, we cannot use those fruits or any divinity within ourself because such things are beyond the human. we must have divinity living inside of us to operate the divine power of God within us, like i said earlier those fruits are not produced by us, we must let the Holy Spirit produce them in our life, and then we must let Him serve them through us, we all have the gifts of God in our life, but we cannot operate even one of them; we have to depend on the Spirit to do that because they are not our gifts but His, we should do our part and make sure that we are yielding to the Spirit through fasting and prayers, and then He puts His gifts into operation, we have to be ready for the Lord to use any one of the nine gifts or all of them. As we yield to Him.

Love

And so we know and rely on the love God has for us, the Bible says in "1 John 4:16" that God is love, and whoever lives in love lives in God, through Jesus Christ, our greatest goal is to do all things in love. "1 Corinthians 13:4-8" says that, Love is patient, love is kind, It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trust, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fail. Love makes you want to give, to set aside one's own preferences, desires, and sometimes even to put the other person first. "Philippians 2:3-5" says, Don't do anything from selfish ambition or from a cheap desire to boast, but be humble towards one another, always considering others better than your-selves. And look out for one another's interests, not just for your own. The attitude you should have is the one that Christ Jesus had.

The Spirit serves us love, and then He serves it through us to others. It is love like the world has never seen before, and we must let people see that love, we must always speak with the first love you received at Calvary, but we will not do that by arguing, if we always argue in our marriage or with anyone else, we will have to stop it or we will still be on Earth together to argue after the Rapture takes place, don't get me wrong as long as we are living in this body there is always going to be disagreements and differences, but we will have to work them out with love, not by talking crazy, or talking on the side of our mouth, Some people think they can argue, fight physically abuse people and still be alright; but the Lord is going to drop us into hell and He will never remember us again if we don't change, Love is stronger than all the powers of the devil. It contains all the light of Heaven, all the divine promises and the whole heart of God,in fact the kingdom of God operate through love, it's the same love that carried the divine blood to Calvary and then shed it to redeem all mankind, and it's the only love that could have done that.

Faithfulness

To be "faithful" simply means to be reliable or trustworthy, every Christian must be faithful and reliable, our faithfulness is required to be continued and consistent submission and obedience to God, we should live our life in accordance with God at all times, yielding completely to the Holy Spirit He will provide the ability for us to be faithful, by the power of the Holy Spirit we shall stand even in times of persecution and trials for Christ sake we will endure and still keep our faithfulness till the end.

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Joy

The Spirit serves joy that the world has never experienced. In "I Peter 1:8" Peter described it as joy unspeakable and full of glory, If you really have the Holy Spirit, you will have Heaven's joy, you will no longer want to be a part of the world. So first choose to rejoice in God and who He is. second, bring all your worries, fear, and concerns to God in prayer. third, fill your mind with God's truth. And fourth, choose to think about the things of God, sometimes us, Christians tend to downplay the meaning of Joy, the word Joy means "gladness and delight" Sadly, the world's joy cannot last because it is based on fleeting, physical circumstances. But the joy of the Lord is established in our Spiritual eternal circumstances. As we cling tight to Jesus, abiding daily, we will experience the fullness of Joy. He promised in "John 15:4-11". and you can't have the anointings of God or His strength without that joy. "Nehemiah 8:10" For the joy of the LORD is your strength.

I don't rely on people for my joy; so if I get any from them, it's just a bonus. brothers and sisters joy and gladness is for each one of His children even when the valleys are deep and the mountains are high, remember what the *Bible says in "Matthew 5:11-12" Blessed are you, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake*. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. It is clear that the Lord tells us to rejoice in Him, still, no matter what's going on around.

Peace

The Bible says in "John 14:27" Peace is what i leave with you; it is my own peace that i give you, I do not give it as the world does. Do not be worried and upset; do not be afraid. The world doesn't offer much peace, just look around, the world connote give it because the world doesn't know the one who is peace, but those who have the Spirit of peace within us, the peace of Christ is possible, no matter what the circumstances are, the Lord gives us peace even when the storms of life are raging, we can reject the chaos of the world and embrace God's peace that our Lord Jesus Christ gives which is beyond all human understanding, the Bible tells us in "Philippians 4:7" it says, And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. If we have the Holy Spirit but we have no peace, it is because we are not letting Him serve it to us. We will have to go through much in this final hour, but we must be peacemakers in all cost.

Longsuffering

Longsuffering, and that is the patience that brings us all things needed and even possesses our souls. "Luke 21:19" says, In your patience possess ye your souls. you do what? Possesses our soul that's deep, no wonder we go through all this troubles the Lord wants us to have patience especially in this last hour, we don't see much patience in the world today, not even in the church, even our cell phone apps everything is instant, now, now, to the point that people don't want to wait for anything anymore, but Christians have the advantage because of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit who's longing to display his character to those around us. In "2 Thessalonians 1:4" says, so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure. Brothers and sisters patient people put up with circumstances that other people cannot, even when severely tried, patient people display endurance, longsuffering, do we? That's the question, we have to be patient even in sharing the Gospel to others, with patience we can have all the promises of God. Some of us ask for patience, but we want it our own way and in our own time. The question is are we in shape to receive patience with that attitude; and, of course, you don't get it. when you pray for patience, expect a big load of tribulations to come your way; but the Bible said it would be that way. "Romans 5:3" And not only that But we also glory in tribulations: knowing that tribulation produces perseverance. Some of you won't pray for patience because you're afraid of the tribulations; but if you'll trust God to be with you, you'll be fine. You'll come through every trial with more patience when you depend on the Holy Spirit and you'll mount up with wings like the eagle. "Isaiah 40:31" it says But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Kindness and Goodness

The characteristics of "kindness" and "goodness" are closely related. together they present the picture of one who not only possesses moral goodness and integrity, but also generously expresses it in the way they act toward others. This "goodness in action" reflects God's kindness and goodness toward us. "Titus 3:4 "God demonstrated His kindness and goodness to us in in our salvation. And He will continue to "show the immeasurable riches of His grace in kindness toward us" for all eternity. "Ephesians 2:7" says He did this to demonstrate for all time to come the extraordinary greatness of his grace in the love he showed us in Christ Jesus.

Gentleness/Meekness

Gentleness is closely linked to humility, gentleness is grace of the soul, it is not weakness, a quiet and gentle Spirit is one of humility and immense love for other people, it means we do not stir up arguments for our own gain or fight anger with anger, patient tongue is like water to a flame. "Ephesians 4:2" with all lowliness and gentleness, with long-suffering, bearing with one another in love. Meekness, is the humility of Jesus; we have to be as humble and meek as the Holy Spirit Himself. We must forgive people and never hold anything against them again; but many will say, "I can't forgive." Then you don't have the Holy Spirit living in you, because the Spirit that carry grudges is from the devil, we cannot have both the devil and God in our life, in "Matthew 6:24" the Bible says that, No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will be loyal to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. You have free choice, but you have to choose one or the other. God or the devil. I have heard people saying that it is healthy to argue please, that's exactly what the devil wants you to do; but you can't have the divine anointing if you always argue. It takes two to argue; so if you have a mate who does that, don't argue back. Then when the Rapture takes place, you will be the one who is taken. In "Matthew 24:40,41" the scripture says, Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

My brothers and sisters, gentleness, is the very touch of God's hand; and He serves divine goodness, which is the attention from the true and living God that will guide all of our steps. Only the Spirit can produce these fruits in us; we can't do much by ourself. like i said before we have to yield completely to the Holy Spirit because He knows how to deal with us. Divine gentleness is the fifth Spirit of God, and every born-again Christian must have it. Without that gentleness, marriages fail. To have a good marriage, we have to have a gentle spirit-gentle in speaking and in giving to each other. When we love our mate like how we love our own flesh, we will want to do things for them that make them happy; and then they'll bless us back. We have to learn to speak with gentleness, The Bible says our conversation is supposed to be the same as it is in Heaven. The bible says in "Philippians 3:20" For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. Do you have heavenly conversations with your mate?

Self-control

Temperance, the last characteristic in Paul's Description of the Fruit of the Spirit points us back to his list, "works of the flesh" read "Galatians 5:19-21" can we control ourselves? Because in our walk with God without self control we will fail miserably. Are we deceived? Because some of us will not face that fact, no matter how much God tries to deal with us. we think we can say and do whatever we want to, and of course we can; but the consequences are too high, be careful He is able to destroy our bodies and our souls. When we have self-control, we will not argue and fight; and we will not yell at, with or mistreat others because that is not the Holy Spirit's way. pray, let her, him or them, argue; by themselves but do not join the argument. only those with the indwelling of Holy Spirit has the strength to control the sinful desires, to say "No" to our flesh, self-control gives us the power to say "Yes" to the Spirit and foster a beautiful, bountiful harvest of Spiritual fruit.

The truth is that we have always been living in the flesh, its time to come out of it and go into the Spirit to receive Him and to walk in Him. I wish we had all been that concerned about our tongues from the time we were born and had not given them over to the devil, but we were careless. When the devil would tell us to lie, we would spit one out; and when something would upset us, we would have angry fits, its time to change, change the gear and fly up, the Holy Spirit is always ready, are you? The Lord has given us His gifts to use for His honor and glory, but I never thought God would count me worthy to receive even one of the gifts. we have to learn how the Holy Spirit uses the miracle power and the gifts in life, we cannot make them work remember that, only when we yield to the Spirit, then, He can use them through us, He will work through us in many different ways too, if you allow him to. Jesus came with truth and grace, and we cannot have this great outpouring of the Holy Spirit without that truth and grace. This is the grace dispensation, and the gifts of the Spirit are in operation; and the fruits of the Spirit are being produced in each godly life, through the Holy Spirit, God can make us into anything He wants us to be if we will let Him be the potter and us the clay. "Isaiah 64:8" But now O LORD, you are our father; we are the clay, and you are potter; and we all are the work of your hand. He will make us into workers for Him who will move on in to do His great will? Will you listen and yield to Him? "Isaiah 30:21" your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, This is the way, walk in it, whenever you turn to the right hand, and whenever you turn to the left.vThe Lord needs all kinds of workers now, and He is always looking for two more hands to use. prayer, fasting and living in the Word are the secrets to victory in Jesus; and if we focus and just do these three things, trust me, we are set. so brothers and sisters It is the Holy Spirit's time, a time not to be ignorant of the nine gifts of the Spirit but to believe them all.

Chapter Three

GRIEVE NOT YOUR SPIRIT

First of all the Holy Spirit must be as real to us as people are, and we have to learn to live with Him, when He moves in, He is there with us day and night so we have to acknowledge Him if not we will grieve Him right out of our lives, He is so holy and has all the wisdom and all the knowledge and he knows every detail of the will of God for our life, the truth is that the Holy Spirit comes into our soul with the understanding that He will have the final authority over our Spirit, He comes in with the understanding that you want Him more than you want anyone or anything else; but when we fail to meet our obligation to Him, He is grieved, the scripture says it clearly in "Ephesians 4:30" it says and do not make God's Holy Spirit sad; for the Spirit is God's mark of ownership on you, a guarantee that the day will come when God will set you free.



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So do you make the Spirit happy or sad? When you have days in which you wonder why you feel sad, depressed or despair, you may want to check and see if it is because you have grieved the Holy Spirit, Have you quenched His flow of greatness from Heaven to you? have you hindered Him from moving for you or serving you? The Bible says in "1 Thessalonians 5:19" it says quench not the Spirit, "Quench" means to put out or to extinguish, and we cannot do that to the Spirit, we cannot put out His inner light of Love and grace, Listen, when we go against the Holy Spirit, we are putting our life in Jeopardy because He can no longer guide us on the paths we should be on or lead us down the roads of righteousness and love, we have to give over to him, lets not make it hard for Him to do the things He wants us to do.

When we give over to self, we grieve the Holy Spirit and Bible told us not to, if we want the reality of divine love, faith, grace, and all the greatness of the Spirit, we must bow to the leading of the Holy Spirit and be so grateful that He is dwelling in us, the Holy Spirit moves in different ways than the human spirit does, so you must learn to separate the two and know when we are not yielding to the spirit like we should. we will save many peoples souls if we follow his lead, the reason why many christians are defeated all the time is because they don't fully depend on the Holy spirit, they may have Him dwelling on the inside of them, but they do not recognize him all the time, so they wander around in a fog of doubt, fear and frustration and that's exactly what the enemy want, so we can see that its not enough just to have the Holy Spirit living inside of us, we must know without a doubt that He is real and He is alive. He has the intelligence, power and greatness of God, and He wants to reveal those things to us, he makes Himself known to us, but if we also don't make ourself known to him, there will be no connection at all.

My brothers and sisters we are missing out, the time is now to connect, He is waiting on us, call upon Him, He has wonderful and deep revelations of the greatness of God Almighty, the personality of Jesus Christ and God's Divine will for us, He will help us through every valley and teach us whatever we need to know, but we must get quiet with Him and be still in His presence sometimes He may lead us to a task that God has for us if we are willing and obedient to do it, but He will never force it on us, Jesus willingly came to earth to suffer and die for us, and because of that, the Spirit kept Him through it all "1 Peter 2:21-22" it says It was to this that God called you, for Christ himself suffered for you and left you an example, so that you would follow in his steps, He committed no sin, and no one ever heard a lie come out from his lips.the Holy Spirit will not only lead us to do the works the Lord God almighty has called us to do, He will also enable us to do them. Jesus knew that he said it clearly in "John 14:12" I am telling you the truth; those who believe in me will do what I do, yes they will do even greater things, wow! that's a strong statement, the Holy Spirit wants to lead us on to greater heights and to do more work for the Lord, but we have to hear what He is saying, it was difficult for me to hear Him too because I was always busy with life, work, bills, taking care of my family, taking my kids to therapists never had time at all, I thank God now that i can hear Him loud and clear.

In "acts 10:19-20" it says Peter was trying to understand what the vision meant, when the Spirit said, "listen! three men are here looking for you, so get ready and go down, and do not hesitate to go with them, for I have sent them, you see its not only the matter of hearing the Spirit we also have to obey the Spirit and that is what Peter did, those men had come from Caesarea and from the house of a centurion named Cornelius, and Peter went with them just like the spirit had told him to, as he preached to those who had gathered at Cornelius's house, the Holy Spirit fell; and they were all baptized in the Spirit.

The Holy Spirit spoke to the Disciples regarding Paul and Barnabas in "Acts 13:2" while they were serving the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said to them, set apart for me Barnabas and Saul (Paul) to do the work to which I have called them, He called those two on a mission and they obeyed, the Holy Spirit told Paul and barnabas where to go and where not to go, that is found in "Acts 16 6". So we have to be sensitive to His voice and be obedient, if He tells us to do something today we can't say that we will do it tomorrow or not doing it at all, that's disobedient.

We are living in the last days our focus has to be on spreading the good news of Jesus Christ, "Mark 16:15" Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature, now its even easy because of social media, Facebook, twitter, Instagram, we can even have a website or an online radio station, let us utilize our profiles to spread the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ, we have to be genuine when it comes to the things of God, that speaking in tongues at will, or let me say (gibberish) just to sound more spiritual, listen, if the Holy Spirit is not involved, guess whose spirit is that? keep your eyes open to the truth, for we are free moral agents, even after the baptism we still have free choice to yield to the Holy Spirit or not to yield to him, remember that we are declared righteous from God, for we are clothed in Christ holiness, we have to learn to see ourselves the way God sees us,let us choose to yield to the Holy Spirit at all times because thats what God wants us to do.



Chapter Four

UNFORGIVABLE SIN

The People who have blasphemed against the Holy Spirit are like the walking dead, they are nothing but a lifeless shell, and they can never be saved; thinking we can get them saved might be the waste of time, the sin of blaspheming against the Holy Spirit is forever, It is the same as being dropped into hell, the danger of it all, is that most people who have blasphemed against the Holy Spirit don't know, because they are blinded by the god of this world, they claim they are all right, but the devil has deceived them, the Bible warns us in "Proverbs 14:12" it says There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death. People who blaspheme are worthless even in the eyes of God, they have no true love for God's Word. They do not stand for the truth because they love false things and the power of the devil, The scripture says it clearly in "Matthew 12:31-32" that Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Spirit shall not be forgiven unto men.

And anyone who speaks a word against the son of man will be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, neither in this world, or in the world to come. If you reject the Lord's great sacrifice at Calvary and speak against God's power, you will take one giant step toward blaspheming against the Holy Spirit, the Pharisees in Jesus' day could not stand the power of God, and they mocked it. In "Matthew 12:22-24" it says Then was brought unto him [Jesus] one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, in so much that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.

And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David? But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow does not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. That was blasphemy against the power of God and the Holy Spirit, God honors the Holy Spirit working in a person's life, and He expects us to respect the work of the Spirit too. Some people will fellowship with those who disrespect God's work and talk against divine miracles and healings, we should never follow after them or let them influence us in any way.

Those who leave the Gospel truth do not want it or believe it, or they never would have gone away from God. They are running from God, and many have fallen into false doctrine. They are deceived into thinking their beliefs are right, but true saints of God do not fight His miracles and His power, *Paul wrote*, in "II Thessalonians 2:10-12" And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

People who reject the Word of God and do whatever they want to, are not led by the Holy Spirit, and they will be damned by God for all eternity, we are either for God or against Him, there is no in between, "Matthew 12:30" the scripture says it clearly He who is not with me is against me; and he who does not gather with me scatters abroad. People who leave the truth may wander around trying to find their place, but they will never get anywhere, no one can come to the Lord unless they are drawn by the Holy Spirit, "John 6:44" says No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draws him. So if you keep insulting and rejecting the Holy Spirit, you will blaspheme against Him; and you will never be drawn to the Lord again.

More people than ever before have turned away from God and blasphemed against the Holy Spirit, and many others are on the verge of blaspheming; and God is angry, every step a person takes that is influenced by the devil leads them closer to blaspheming, so we must know and understand the steps to blaspheming against the Holy Spirit; and they must become real to us, we will be in grave danger if we disobey God in anything, no matter how small it may be. The Bible tells us that the little things are the ones that can hurt us the most. "(Song of Solomon 2:15)" says Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines have tender grapes. we must carefully consider each step before we take it to see if it is a step the Lord wants us to take or the one we want to take.


God warns us in His Word not to take steps to blasphemy because He loves us so much, many people will not admit even to themselves that they have visited the wrong tree, and they become hypocrites, they can no longer stand the power of God in a God's true people, so they start to criticize and find fault, that draws them deeper into the devil's clutches until they begin to mock the work of God and say that divine miracles are not real and that God's prophecies are not true, when people fight what God is doing and declare that His works are the works of the devil, they are on the road to blaspheming against the Holy Spirit, they may continue to go to church, but they carry a spirit of hypocrisy; and they want to destroy others by getting them to turn against God too, then in His wrath and judgment, God sweeps such people out of the midst of His children because He does not want His work to be hindered.

The light of God shines brightly for those who choose to follow Jesus, but there is only darkness for those who do not follow Him. In "I John 1:5-6" the Bible tells us that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, yet at the same time live in darkness, we are lying both in our words and in our action. God hates liars; and the Lord said, in "Revelation 21:8" All liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. Either you believe the truth of God or you don't. You are forgiven or not forgiven, walking in His light or in darkness, living in His love or in hate, many of us, are so deceived that they have no feeling toward God whatsoever. In "Ephesians 4:17-19" It says in the Lord's name, then i warn you: do not continue to live like the heathen, whose thoughts are worthless and whose minds are in the dark, they have no part in the life that God gives, for they are completely ignorant and stubborn, they have lost all feeling of shame; they give themselves over to vice and all sorts of indecent things without restraint. They let their hearts grow so hard that they will not even accept the love of God's children who are trying to help them, and they are headed for destruction.

"Proverbs 29:1" says He who is being often rebuked hardens his neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy. People will love either God or the devil, if you chose God, then you never have to fear anyone or anything because as the Bible says in "Isaiah 54:17" that No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is from me, says the LORD. but if we let the devil deceive us and win our soul and we blasphemy, God will shut us away forever and never hear our voice again. In "Proverbs 6:15" the Bible says that Therefore shall his calamity come suddenly; suddenly shall he be broken without remedy. "(Ezekiel 18:20)" The soul that sins shall die. That will be the fate of the spiritually dead who are walking on Earth today, those who have blasphemed against the Holy Spirit.

My Brothers and sisters heaven does not forgive blasphemy, its clear that God had His dispensation; Jesus had His dispensation, and now we are in the last dispensation—the dispensation of the Holy Spirit, we must think and live the Gospel truth with all of its power and never let anyone convince us to do differently. Paul told the Galatians, in book of "Galatians 1:8" says but even if we, or an Angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. The Lord is saying the same thing to us: If we accept any doctrine other than the truth, we will be cursed by God, Paul obeyed God in all things, and obedience means everything; but we cannot be obedient both to God and to our sinning family members, we cannot do what we want to do; we have to do what the Spirit wants us to do.

If you have the Holy Spirit, know that you have royalty living with you; but are you obedient to Him? or to those who are influenced by the devil? If we fail to take our stand, we will hinder people from coming to God; and whenever we compromise, we will lose, I pray that God helps us never to seek to please people; we must seek to please the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, God gave the Word, and the Holy Spirit to save us from destruction; but when you and i, reject their instructions, and join those who criticize God, make fun of His power and the Holy Spirit, then God will lift His power from us, and there will be no hope for us.



Chapter Five

BLASPHEMERS

The word blasphemy means the action or offense of speaking sacrilegiously about God or sacred things; in other words it simply means profane talk, Do you remember what happen to Lot's wife, get this picture when you blaspheme against God you will also became like worthless piece of salt, if you study the lives of those who blasphemed, the first thing you will see is stubbornness, rebellion, a lack of trust in God and dissatisfaction with His work, you will see despair and carelessness and people walking on the wrong side of God's will, you will see those who judge God's work and His people and those whose roads are littered with stones of the devil's deceit, strife, bitterness and twisted knowledge, not one ray of God's sunshine breaks through the devil's dark fog that covers their lives, and they are spiritually blind and deaf to the things of God, if you are reading this right now and what I have listed down are your tendencies know that you are at the wrong side, turn back to God quickly before its too late.

Blasphemers do not see the beauty in divine works of God, miracles, healing, or casting out of devils, and they are always ready to accuse just as the pharisees were in Jesus's day. In "Matthew 12.9-14" it says Jesus left that place and went to a synagogue where there was a man who had a paralyzed hand, some people were there (pharisees) who wanted to accuse Jesus of doing wrong, so they ask Him, Is it against our Law to heal on the sabbath? Jesus answered, What if one of you has a sheep and it falls into a deep hole on the sabbath? Will you not take hold of it and lift it out? And a human being is worth much more than a sheep! so then, our Law does allow us to help someone on the sabbath, then he said to the man with the paralyzed hand, stretch out your hand, he stretched it out, and he became well again, just like the other one. then the pharisees left and made plans to kill Jesus. it is clear that the pharisees did not care that the man needed a miracle, they just wanted to find fault with Jesus and justify their doubt, and those same kinds of people exist today.

Jesus told the disciples to leave behind those who reject God's truth and power, *lets see what the scripture says in "Luke 9:5" it says wherever people don't welcome you, leave that town and shake the dust off your feet as a warning to them.* Sometimes because of love we tend to insist on telling people about the Good news of Jesus christ. I remember my best friend told me not to insist telling people about the good news of Jesus Christ, and that they should change their lifestyle, its just that when the Holy spirit is working in you, you can't keep quiet, praise God for salvation comes from Him and he will always lead you to someone who is craving for the word.

Eternal damnation is the destiny of blasphemers and nothing can change that, they have rejected God and His correction, so there is no hope for them. Lets see what the scripture says in "Proverbs 1:24-33" It says i have been calling you, inviting you to come, but you would not listen, you paid no attention to me, you have ignored all my advise and have not been willing to let me correct you, so when you get into trouble, I will laugh at you, I will mock you when terror strikes, when it comes on you like a storm, bringing fierce winds of trouble, and you are in pain and misery, then you will call for wisdom, but i will not answer, you may look for me everywhere, but you will not find me, you have never had any use for knowledge and have always refused to obey the Lord, you have never wanted my advice or paid any attention when I correct you, so then, you will get what you deserve, and your own actions will make you sick, inexperienced people die because they reject wisdom, stupid people are destroyed by their own lack of concern, but whoever listens to me will have security, he will be safe, with no reason to be afraid.

Those who reject God, will be out of reach of the divine blood; and without the blood, there is no forgiveness for sin. "Hebrews 9:21" says in the same way moses also sprinkled the blood on the sacred Tent and over all the things used in worship, indeed, according to the Law almost everything is purified by blood, and sins are forgiven only if blood is poured out. "Hebrew 10:4-14" says for the blood of bulls and goats can never take way sins, for this reason, when Christ was about to come into the world, He said to God; "you do not want sacrifices and offerings, but you have prepared a body for me, you are not pleased with animals burnt whole on the alter, or with sacrifices to take away sins. Then I said, Here I am, to do your will, O God just as it is written of me in the book of the Law." First he said, you neither want nor are you pleased with sacrifices and offerings or with animals burnt on the alter and the sacrifices to take away sins." He said this even though all these sacrifices are offered according to the Law, then he said, "Here I am, O God, to do your will." so God does away with all the old sacrifices and puts the sacrifice of Christ in their place, because Jesus Christ did what God wanted him to do, we are all purified from sin by the offering that He made of his own body once for all.

Every jewish priest performs his services every day and offers the same sacrifices many times; but these sacrifices can never take away sins, Christ however, offered one sacrifice for sins, an offering that is effective forever, and then He sat down at the right-hand side of God, there He now waits until God puts his enemies as a footstool under His feet, with one sacrifice, then, He has made perfect for ever those who are purified from sin.

If you have backslide and you are reading this right now, don't wait any longer the time is now, you need Jesus Christ for we are perfect only through Him, we made a lot mistakes we didn't know better and God knew that, its time to do better now, He is a merciful God turn to Him right now, repent and ask for forgiveness, He will forgive you, He will cleanse you with the divine blood of Jesus Christ and He will open your eyes, and your ears to the truth, the choice is yours, repeat this prayer with me.

Oh, God, Almighty Father I am so lost I don't want to drift out into the world And not be able to come back, i am so sorry that I have sinned against you, please forgive me, I am coming to you today. Save my soul and take away any sin that is in me. Lukewarmness or spirit of indifference. Set me free Lord. For who ever the son has set free, he is free indeed. I give myself to you Father, and I will serve you all the days of my life.

I believe the divine blood of Jesus Christ that was spilled on Calvary Washes away all of my sins. Come into my heart My Lord, I ask this In Jesus mighty name Amen!

If you meant that prayer, Jesus has come; and He is yours, you are restored. Start praying, fasting and read your Bible, if you don't have a Bible contact me, I will give you one.



Chapter Six

THE TIME IS NOW

It is time to take seriously the vision of the end time hour and run with it, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us "Hebrews 12:1" the Spirit is always pushing us forward, we are living in the most degraded age that has ever been on earth and there is no longer any middle ground, the powers of darkness are so strong that people will go one way or the other, he is on a mission of sweeping as many many people as he can over his side many of us are allowing him to do that remember he is powerless he can't control our minds he can only influence our thoughts and watch us do the rest by ourselves, the Lord gives us warnings over and over again because He loves us so much and he wants us to follow in his footsteps from now until the day of rapture, we need direction from the Holy Spirit otherwise we will take a detour into the wrong road and fall into traps ending up in situations that are not God's will that's why Jesus told us to pray always not once or twice but always "Luke 21:36" says watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and do stand before the son of Man. We are definitely end-time people, and I am going to listen to the Holy Spirit just as the Bible tells us to no matter what anybody else might think or do, he that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says, speak out what the Spirit tells you to, the time is now don't be afraid, or intimidated give people God's thoughts wherever you go, for this is the day of great visitation and great revelation, and the move of God is on, this is our hour, but what condition are we in?



The Apostles back then didn't worry about what others said; they just asked the Lord to give them more of His grace and power. in "Acts 4:29-31" the Bible says that, Now, Lord, look their threats, and grant to your servants, that with all boldness they may speak your word, By stretching out your hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness. Brothers and sisters, the Bible is clear without the Holy Spirit there is not much that we can do, so many churches today are spiritually dead and do not have divine love and compassion for the lost souls, there are dead men and women in the pulpits and dead people in the pews who do not have the Jesus vision, Some people say that it is false doctrine to teach that people must have the Holy Spirit, and others who actually claim to have the Holy Spirit are really just speaking in tongues at will, know that speaking in tongues at will is demonic; if you continue doing that, just know that the lord is not in it, and if the lord is not in it, guess whose spirit is that.

Chapter Seven

In "Matthew 5:8" the scripture says Blessed are the pure in heart; for they shall see God. Brothers and sisters no matter what people say, if their heart is not right, they are not right. "Matthew 15:8" listen to what this verse says This people draweth high unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lip;but their hearts is far from me. when God has our whole heart, we will reason with Him instead of people. Also in "Isaiah 1:18" it says come now, and let us reason together, says the Lord, He is simply saying that "Lets talk" and He wants us to come to Him and live in His presence, trust me theres no other place to be than to be in the Lord's presence. Everything is at our disposal all of that comes with the anointing, and it's within our reach; but we must have a holy heart before we can have the holy hands we need to reach for it. we have to live free from sin to be able to reach his power, to trample the enemy under our feet, the Bible tells us in "I John 3:7" says Let no one deceive you, my children whoever does what is right is righteous, just as Christ is righteous. Whoever continues to sin belongs to the devil, because the devil has sinned from the very beginning, the Son of God appeared for this very reason, to destroy what the devil had done, non of those who are children of God continue to sin, for God's very nature is in them; and because God is their father, they cannot continue to sin, this is a clear difference between God's children and the devil's children: all who do not do what is right or do not love others are not God's children, a sinner can't be of God. The first Adam was perfect in all of his ways until he fell into sin; but thank God that when the Second Adam came. He remained perfect, the devil thought he could cause Jesus to fall, but he couldn't; and Satan will fail with all of us too, if we continue to live sin free, God is offering us all of His power that we will use, but we have to have a perfect heart.

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In "James 5:7" the bible says be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord, behold, the husbandman waiteth for precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. The Lord wants us to be ready to receive the great pouring out of the Spirit, but we won't be able to receive what God is offering us unless we have a holy heart, we are not going to see the pouring out without holy, clean eyes, and we won't hear what the Spirit is saying without holy ears. "If have you ears, then, listen to what the Spirit says to the churches "Revelation 2:7." We must have the ears of God so that we can hear the Spirit. those are the same kind of ears Adam and Eve had in Eden before they sinned and lost their spiritual hearing, today, many people and even church members lack true spiritual hearing, and they do not hear what the Spirit is saying.


The Book of Acts illustrates how alive in the Spirit the apostles became after Pentecost. Before that time, there had been such a deadness in their spirits, even though Jesus was walking so closely with them. Jesus is close by people today, but they won't ask Him into their hearts. nothing is happening in many churches because the ministers won't let God work, just as there was no room for the Christ Child in the inn at the time of His birth, people have no room for Him in their hearts.

We don't have to slow down now the times are hard we are indeed living in the last days we have to continue to seek God diligently if not eventually we will turn away because we won't walk in the Spirit. The Bible tells us in "Galatians 5:16" what I say is this: let the Spirit direct your lives and you will not satisfy the desires of the human nature, for what our human nature wants is opposed to what the Spirit wants, and what the Spirit wants is opposed to what our human nature wants, If we will respond to the leading of the Holy Spirit, our life will be more fruitful and more fulfilled. we may hold an important position in the church, but we cannot rely on that position as our passport to Heaven.

We must always seek to go deeper with the Lord. we must meet with Him in the closet of consecration and dedication because God does not want us to respond to Him only with lip service or outward actions, God draws us with great love, and He wants a heartfelt response; but for some, it is just an outward thing. People may say one thing, but that doesn't mean their heart is in it. they make promises with only their mouth, and that is no good.

In this last days we have to hide the word in our hearts for more than just keeping us from sin; it must be your life and our discipline, we must live according to every word contained in it because everything you need is there, "Psalms 119:11" says thy word have i hid in mine heart, that i might not sin against thee, Jesus was the word made flesh, and He brought the word to us. "John 1:14" says the word became a human being and, full of grace and truth, lived among us, we saw His glory, the glory which He received as the Father's only son.

Its clear enough that nothing stand against Jesus He is at the gate of every heart, so let Him in and always put Him first. Praise Him, delight in Him and behold His divine blood and power,through divine love and grace, God has been patient to deal with people, He has knocked at their hearts' doors many times, and He has tried to reveal His glory to them in many ways. Unfortunately, all will not respond, but it is to their own detriment. we may excuse ourselves when God calls on us to do something saying, "I'm too busy"; but you should never be too busy to do God's work. His work must always come first in your life. He must not have just one of your hands; He must have both of them.



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Chapter Eight

The word is God's love massage to us throughout our journey here on earth, it is a beautiful love letter that can be opened any time of the night or day, check that love often and hear the Lord saying, I am with with you always, I will never leave you, nor forsake you, so my brothers and sisters, are you free in the Gospel? It is the only real freedom on Earth today; everything else is a bondage. If you are not living in the liberty of the Gospel, you are in bondage. Jesus said, Know the truth, and the truth shall make you free "John 8:32". Jesus was saying, "Know me and be free. walk hand in hand with me and have the liberty of Heaven." A lot of Christians struggle even to believe that God answers their prayers, and they are always begging God for something. They are like beggars in rags when they should be wrapped in the Lord's robe of righteousness. We are rich in the Lord, so we don't have to beg; and there is a robe of righteousness for every child of God. His table is filled, and He has given us two hands to reach out and take all He offers. Jesus said, Ask, and you shall receive "John 16:24". That is all you have to do, don't think too much about it. Remember to seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you, "Matthew 6:33" this verse is a secret to a successful life you have always dreamed of, Remember to put love in everything you do. I have a question for you? Do you really love Jesus whole heartedly? Do you show the Lord that you love him first when you wake up in the morning? Do you always put God first in everything? if you don't put God first. You will allow yourself or others to come between you and the Lord, and they will become more important to you.

Jesus brought us the anointing to grow and prosper like a tree planted by the river. In "psalms 1:3" says And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. Brothers and sisters. If we are not prospering spiritually, physically or financially, we have to get into the divine will of God and give our life completely to Him. we have to give to the Lord in tithes to the needy, give thanks to God always and praise offerings with the humility of Jesus, and then God's promise of supply will be ours. But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus "Philippians 4:19".

Do not let anyone hinder you from serving God? Paul asked the Galatians, you foolish Galatians! who put a spell on you? Before your very eyes you had a clear description of the death of Jesus Christ on the cross! Tell me one thing: did you receive God's Spirit by doing what the Law requires or by hearing the Gospel and believing it? How can you be so foolish! you began by God's Spirit; do you now want to finish by your own power? Did your experience mean nothing at all? Surely it meant something! does God give you the Spirit and work miracles among you because you do what the Law requires or because you hear the Gospel and believe it? Consider the experience of Abraham; as the scripture says, because he believed God, and because of his faith God accepted him as righteous, you should realize then, that the real descendants of Abraham are the people who have faith. The scripture predicted that God would put the Gentiles right with himself through faith. And so the scripture announced the good news to Abraham; through you God will bless the whole human race. Abraham believed and he was blessed; so all who believe are blessed as he was, this is found in "Galatians 3:1-9" the Gospel is truth, and it is the only thing that can set you free, in "Galatians 5:7" it says, you were doing so well! who made you stop obeying the truth?

If you are a child of God, you are responsible for the truth Jesus brought to earth through the power of the Holy Spirit. You must stand on that truth, live in it and recognize it in action or you will lose it. "Luke 11:35 " make certain, then that the light in you is not darkness. brothers and sisters your light will turn to darkness when you turn against God and fall away from the truth.

Do you make the Lord happy by the way you serve Him, or do you grieve Him by the things you listen to or watch? True Christians have no business watching shows that are filthy, lewd and suggestive, or ones in which people blaspheme God's name.

This is not a time to compromise with the world in any way or to waste time with things that do not strengthen and bless the inner man. Does listening to worldly music bless your inner man? Those who are on fire for God will not voluntarily listen to things of the world. The Bible says in "Ephesians 5:19" Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord.

Anointed music and singing can drive out evil spirits just as David's music did when he played for Saul. And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from the Lord was upon Saul [That means God had allowed it to come.], that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him "I Samuel 16:23".

On the other hand, worldly music and singing can bring in the wrong spirits; and the spirit of compromise is one of those wrong spirits. The Bible says, Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. "Romans 12:2" says You can only show forth the perfect will of God by being in step with Him and by making sure your heart is beating in rhythm with His.

We have to be careful with the music we listen to, when we sing or listen to worldly music, it creates a discord between us and God; and many people have been swept into the arms of Lucifer by listening to the wrong music. When God draws on you, the Holy Spirit will lead you with great patience to follow that pulling; being led by the Holy Spirit is a blessing. When the mighty God, the great I-Am, is calling us into His everlasting arms of love and grace, we must realize the great value of that calling and set aside everything to obey it.



I am not the healer; I am only a vessel for the Lord, and I believe in miracles because I believe in God. Lets pray, Jehovah God almighty father I bring the sick and afflicted to you. I bring those with Corona virus, H.I.V Aids, leprosy, cancer, heart trouble, diabetes, blindness, paralysis or any other kind of affliction. Precious Lord, your Word declares that with your blood, we are healed. Heal, in the all-powerful name of Jesus Christ! Heal! The scripture says in "Isaiah 53:5" But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. Chapter Nine

THE STRENGTH WE NEED

We must understand that the Holy Spirit came to? Earth to give us all things, all the strength we needed, the Spirit will work with us and through us, so we will be able to work with Him just like our left hand works with our right hand, they cooperate with each other and work together; and if they don't, they cannot accomplish for us what they should. We have to work with the Holy Spirit in the same way, in complete harmony and unity we must know Him in the good times and in the bad times, we must know that in our hours of discouragement, sorrow, heartache and disappointment, all will not be lost because the Spirit will lift us up, not put us down; and He will give us all the help we need, we must know that the One who dwells in us is greater than all the demons and devils in the world, It is not enough just to know ourselves; we have to look at ourselves. Most of us know what we would do, what we would think and what we would say in a certain situation because we know ourselves and our abilities quite well; but we have to know our inabilities too, hand them over to the Holy Spirit before the enemy takes advantage of it, we have to know what we can, and cannot do, and then we have to know the Holy Spirit's strength just as well as we know our own. In the physical, we know what we can do and what we can't; and when we don't have strength anymore, we have to know that the Holy Spirit, our helper, is there to lift whatever burdens we cannot bear on our own, the Holy Spirit must be the strength and power of our life so that nothing can defeat us. "Romans 8:35-37" That is why Paul was able to say, Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. In all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Jesus came to destroy all the powers of the enemy, we are free to fly like an eagle, the Lord wants to give us revelations on His divine power and strength; but if we don't seek Him with our whole heart, we'll come up lacking. It is important for us to know that our strength comes from God, physically and spiritually, fasting is the first step if we want to walk hand in hand with God, In "I kings 19:4-8" it says Elijah walked a whole day into the wilderness he stopped and sat down in the shade of a tree and wished he would die, its too much Lord, he prayed, take away my life; I might as well be dead, he lay down under the tree and fell asleep, suddenly an angel touched him and said, wake up and eat, he looked around and saw a loaf of bread and a jar of water near his head, he ate and drank and lay down again, the Lord's angel returned and woke him up a second time, saying get up and eat, or the journey will be too much for you, Elijah got up, ate and drank, and the food gave him enough strength to walk 40 days to Sinai the holy mountain.

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Elijah went on for forty days and nights in the strength of just two meals, cooked by an angel, its obvious that the ingredients came straight from Heaven, the divine Anointing is given the same way, it has all the ingredients to give us the right amount of strength we need, we must yield to God completely, focusing on the word and fasting, because fasting helps us to see ourself in ways we never have before, it reveals our weakness, our shortcomings and habits that hinder our walk with God, after the fast we will always come out refreshed with a clean mind, your flesh may try to keep you from not fasting, don't listen to the flesh no matter how weak you feel, fasting and prayer bind the fresh and the devil, I always get sick every time I start my fast, but I never broke one fast that God called me on, no matter how weak Iwas, I would pray for strength and God would give me the strength I needed.

Study the signs, wonders and miracles God used to bring Israel out of Egyptian bondage, He poured out his power upon people who did not know much about God, and most of them had worshiped idols. God drew them away from idol worship long enough to rescue them and bring them out of Egypt; but they did not stay away, while moses was receiving the Ten Commandments from God on Mount Sinai, the people insisted Aaron make them an idol, a golden calf, they were accustomed to bowing down to a golden calf because it was one of the gods of the Egyptians, so as you can see these people were not holy or had claimed his promises of deliverance, God brought them out because He loved Abraham and his great faith, and He honored the covenant, He made with Abraham. In "Genesis 12:2" it says I will give you many descendants, and they will become a great nation, I will bless you, and make your name famous, so that you will be a blessing.

The old testament is filled with glimpse and shadows of living realities to come; and today, we have those realities in the New testament, which is the will of God, Jesus died left us that will, so everything in the New testament belongs to the children of God, how much of the bible have you used? You find Jesus greatness, power and love in the bible; but have you used those things? The bible is for us to use here on earth, it is a road map that will direct us to heaven, after the destination we won't need it, we will have Jesus the living word, and God the father with us forever.

So after we receive salvation, we must go on to receive the power of the Holy Spirit and then use it, we must serve the power of the Holy Spirit to others because that is how God's work is done, it was the power of the Holy Spirit that did so many marvelous works through the apostles in the beginning of the church, and He will do marvelous works through us today, we can't let nothing stop us now, we have to move forward with the same Spirit of humility and obedience that Jesus had, we have to be ready and never back down, Paul was ready and he said in "Acts 21:13" I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus. Paul was ready to preach the gospel, now its all different a lot of christians are so afraid to speak the truth, everybody attacks you when you speak the truth, the world hated Jesus for the same reasons. In "1 John 2:15-17" says Do not love the world or anything that belongs to the world, if you love the world, you do not love the father, everything that belongs to the world - what the sinful self desires, what people see and want, and everything in this world that people are so proud of - non of this comes from the father; it all comes from the world, the world and everything in it that people desire is passing away; but those who do the will of God live forever.

God is drawing all those who will take heed to Him, and He is drawing with such great force that all you have to do is get rid of your thoughts and desires and take Him. In "Isaiah 55:8-9" the scripture says my thoughts, says the Lord, are not like yours, and my ways are different from yours, as high as the heavens are above the earth, so high are my ways and thoughts above yours. So let us be obedient to the Holy Spirit and follow his lead, let us live in the cloud of God's presence with the fire of the Holy Spirit burning within, and nothing will stop us believe that, we have to learn about the Holy Spirit. in fact, Paul had such great knowledge about divinity that even Peter found some of the things Paul said hard to understand; "2 peter 3:16" but Paul had been determined to learn everything he could. Jesus and the Holy Spirit were paramount in all of Paul's writings.

Paul knew the importance of the Holy Spirit, and began to call down the Spirit upon others, "Acts 19:1-7" says while Apollos was in corinth, Paul travelled through the interior of the providence and arrived in Ephesus, there he found some disciples and asked them, did you receive the Holy spirit when you became believers? we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit, they answered, well, then, what kind of baptism did you receive? Paul asked, the baptism of John, they answered, Paul said, the baptism of John was for those who turned from their sins; and he told the people of Israel to believe in the one who was coming after him, that is, in Jesus, when they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus, Paul placed his hands on them, and the Holy Spirit came upon them; they spoke in strange tongues and also proclaimed God's message.

We also must know the Holy Spirit's power, His greatness, His compassion and His patience, and we must know how He serves those things, then we will always give him the freedom He needs to move, the Lord wants us to study and understand the personalities of Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit just as Paul did, we study personalities of people we want to get to know, so why not divinity? Parents learn the personalities of their children even if they have a dozen of them; and a parent can tell you that no two children are exactly alike, even if they are twins, the divine wisdom and knowledge of God are in His anointing; *In "James 1:5" the bible says but if any of you lack wisdom, you should pray to God, who will give it to you; because God gives generously and graciously to all, God will never rebuke us for asking Him for more of His wisdom and knowledge.*

The Holy Spirit is alive in us, why are we always troubled, complaining over and over again about our situation, if an angel of God would come and whisper in your ear and say the Lord sent me to tell you not to worry everything will be just fine, you would almost sprout wings and fly away, well the Holy Spirit is greater and has more power than all the angels put together, yet we continue to struggle every day with the Holy spirit within, if the Lord intended for us to fight our own battles, then why did He send us the Holy Spirit and all that power from On High? this is a Holy Spirit hour we must know who the Holy Spirit is, we have to let Him use us, how much power does a gun have just sitting in the corner? will it protect you from an intruder No! unless you use it, right? Through the Holy Spirit we have power over everything; but it cannot work for us unless we let Him use it through us, Jesus told us also that the Holy Spirit would bring power. In "Acts 1:8" it says but when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you will be filled with power, and you will be witnesses for me in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth, brother and sisters we are to be witnesses for the Lord and to take His place here on Earth, He wants to use our tongues just as the Father and the Holy Spirit used Jesus tongue when He was here.

In the book of "Matthew 3:11" it says I will baptize you with water to show that you have repented, but the one who will come after me will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire, John the baptist knew about the power even before Jesus started His ministry, God sent Jesus to us so we could have this power, He brought, He came along with the divine blood, the divinity, the anointing and all the strength we needed, all the favor, the grace and the power of God. In "Matthew 28:18-19" the scripture says Jesus drew near and said to them, I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth, go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples; baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything i have commanded you, and I will be with you always, to the end of the age.

We must be active spiritually, the Holy Spirit can give us Boldness, the early Church knew they needed it and they prayed, "Acts 4:29-31" it says, and now Lord, take notice of the threats they have made, and allow us, your servants, to speak your message with all boldness, stretch out your hand to heal, and grant that wonders and miracles may be performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus, when they finished praying, the place where they were meeting was shaken, they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to proclaim God's message with boldness. That's exactly the strength we need.

There may be times when you don't feel like you have the strength to do what God wants you to, but the Spirit will give you the strength you need that comes with the Lord's anointing, and you can receive the same anointing Jesus used when he was here. He said in "Luke 4:18" the Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor, he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised. We must let the Holy Spirit become the strength and power of our life, then we will be more than a conqueror just as Paul was, and nothing can defeat us, when the enemy comes in like a flood, we must yield to the Spirit; and he will give us the strength we need.



Chapter Ten

EARLY CHURCH MIND SET

Just like in the beginning of the Church, the Apostles went everywhere preaching the Word of God and use the blood, the name of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit moved tremendously we can use the same power, greatness, love and faith that fell on the Day of Pentecost, everything is still on, God hasn't changed, and Jesus lives! I know, that's not what our spiritually dead preachers are saying, the great outpouring of the Holy Spirit the Early Church received is our example for today. do we have the Holy Spirit inside of us? Do we have that power? If so, what are we doing with it? Are we going to doubt it, or will we accept it and use it? the people in the Early Church walked just like Jesus, are we?

Only after the disciples received that baptism that's when they were properly equipped to carry out the great commission Jesus gave: In "Matthew 28:19" Go therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. In "Mark 16:17-18" it says And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. Marvelous signs and wonders took place through the greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit, eagerly, the Early Church disciples received that great commission, and that is why they went to the upper Room in one mind and one accord to receive the greatness of the fire of the Spirit. Oh, what a great commission Jesus gave, and we must hear it as the Early Church heard it. It hasn't changed, and it is for all people today, Just as that greatness was necessary for the Early Church, it is necessary for us today; and the fire of the Spirit is falling in this final hour, the fire of the Holy Spirit will burn out of us all that is unlike our Master until we are in one mind and one accord and come into the unity of His Spirit and His love.

The Early church used the power of the Holy Spirit, they evangelized the known world at that time, the more they were persecuted, the more they scattered. However, they didn't scatter in fear; they took the Gospel with them, and they went everywhere talking about Jesus, and look at us, can we do that? If trouble shows up some of us would give up so quickly, we know the truth, but we would rather keep our mouth shut, we can't deny the fact that the Holy Spirit dwells in us, God did not give us the spirit of fear, so let us carry the Gospel to the world in this final hour, lets go! just like the way corona virus was spreading, we have to make this Gospel to be a pandemic that spreads everywhere.

The miracle power will move for us and others in greater and greater ways, Peter received that fire of the Holy Spirit; and immediately afterward, he stood up to people who had recently demanded the death of Jesus. "You crucified Him! You crucified Him!" he cried. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, Peter was changed from a weakling who denied Christ into a mighty force for God; and many souls were added to the Kingdom that day. In "Acts 2:43" says, And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles. The signs and wonders that were done by the Apostles through the greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit thrilled many hearts. If we continue in Acts chapter "5:12-14-16" it says, And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; and they were all with one accord in solomon's porch. And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women. Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one, every person who was brought before them was healed! the works of the Holy Spirit is so wonderful, in the name of Jesus and through the power of the Holy Spirit. In "Acts 9:34" Peter said to a man who had been bedridden with palsy for eight years, Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you, arise, and make your bed. And he arose immediately.

The Holy Spirit performed a great miracle through Peter, in "Acts 9:40-42" in Joppa where the Church was in deep mourning over the death of one of their dear workers. But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up. And he gave her his hand, and lifted her up, and when he had called the saints and widows, presented her alive. And it was known throughout all Joppa; and many believed in the Lord. While Peter was yet in Joppa, a Gentile named Cornelius sent for him. Why?—because Cornelius had seen an angel of the Lord in a vision; and the angel had said, in "Acts 10:4-6" says your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God. And now send men to Joppa, and send for Simon, whose surname is Peter, he will tell you what you must do. At the same time, the Lord had given Peter a vision and showed him that the Gentiles as well as the Jews needed to hear the message of Christ. So Peter traveled to the house of Cornelius and preached the message of Christ to him, his friends and his relatives. "Believe on Christ Jesus and receive remission of their sins," Peter told them. In the same chapter "Acts 10:44-46" While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also, For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. the greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit is for all people who love God.

Peter's next statement makes a distinction between water baptism and the baptism in the Holy Spirit, in same chapter "Acts 10:47" He said, Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized, who have received the Holy Spirit, just as we have? Peter then spread the news of the Holy Spirit falling to the other disciples. In "Acts 11:15" saying, And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them, as on us at the beginning. What had happened when the fire of the Holy Spirit fell on them at the beginning? they spoke in tongues as the Spirit gave utterance, Peter went on in verse 16, to say, Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, John indeed baptized with water; but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit. The Bible says that those who do the will of God will be persecuted,"II Timothy 3:12" Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. And the Early Church disciples knew all about that, at one time, James, the brother of John, was killed; and Peter was thrown into prison, but the brethren didn't give up on him, they prayed to God for him without ceasing, and the greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit went into action. Although Peter was bound between two soldiers, he was sleeping; "Acts 12:7-9" and the Angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shone in the prison: and he struck Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise quickly, And his chains fell off from his hands. And the angel said to him, Gird yourself, and tie on your sandals. And so he did. And he said to him, put on your garment and follow me, so he went out, and followed him; and did not know that what was done by the Angel was real, but thought he was seeing a vision. That angel led Peter through the prison gate and out onto the street— that's what the power of the Holy Spirit can do. through that power, the disciples carried the news of the saving Christ to the known world at that time. When they were rejected, they just shook the dust from their feet and went on their way full of joy, "Acts 13:52" says And the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Spirit. They spoke boldly in the name of Jesus, and the Lord granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

The miracles of God and the greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit caused the kingdom of Lucifer to rage, the faithful disciples of the Early Church were buffeted, brutalized and battered; and yet they stood, there was no room for those who were not deeply committed to the cause of Christ because lukewarm Christians cannot claim the greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit. It was the dedicated, consecrated ones like Paul and Silas who carried that fire and evangelized the known world of their day, at one time, Paul and Silas were beaten with many stripes and cast into prison; yet they had such great reality of the Holy Spirit that at midnight, "Acts 16:25-26" Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them, suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and everyone's chains were loosed. Not only were Paul, Silas and the other prisoners freed, but the jailer was completely shaken; and he cried, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household. How did the world look upon those faithful few? In "Acts 17:6" they described them,as these that have turned the world upside down.

The greatness of the Holy Spirit in Paul compelled him to say, in "Acts 20:23-24-27" The Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me, But none of these things move me, nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry, which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God. For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God. The greatness of the fire of the Holy Spirit molded the mind of Paul in such a miraculous way that he wrote a stirring legacy of faith that was made possible through divine blood, love and truth. In "Romans 8:35-37-39" it says Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord, this passage is it, there is no need for anyone to doubt God's love towards us.

The Early Church disciples did not hinder the work of the Lord, but God showed them how much He disapproved of people who did wrong in his face, when He killed two people for telling just one lie, only one lie, "Acts 5:1-6" But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, And kept back part of the proceeds, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet. But Peter said, Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit, and to keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? While it remained, was it not your own? and after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? you have not lied to men but to God. And Ananias hearing these words fell down and breathed his last, so great fear came upon all those who heard these things.

And the young men arose, wrapped him up, carried him out, and buried him. God was not angry with Ananias for keeping part of the profit but for lying about it, and his wife did the same thing. In "Acts 5:7-11" the scripture says that, And it was about the space a few hours after, when his wife, came in, not knowing what had happened, And Peter asked her, Tell me whether you sold the land for so much? And she said, Yes, for so much. Then Peter said to her, How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out. Then immediately she fell down at his feet, and breathed her last, and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her out, buried her by her husband. And great fear came upon all the church, and all who heard these things. That incident with Ananias and Sapphira put fear in anyone who even thought about doing wrong.

God worked hard to keep the Early Church pure, and it stayed that way for years and years, God meant business then, and He means business now. Jesus is coming very soon, and His Bride must be spotless,"Ephesians 5:27" That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having a spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. A blemish can be so tiny that it is almost invisible, but you cannot have anything in your spirit unlike God.



Chapter Eleven

QUESTION GOD BEFORE GOING YOUR OWN WAY

Everything you want to know is found in the bible, read your Bible and pray without ceasing, even small prayers work, player, fasting and living in the Word of God these are the three things that will take us into the greatness of God and His love. God loves you. No one has ever loved you like He loves you, and no one has ever cared like He cares. What a God He is, a great outpouring of His Spirit is falling on all flesh, but many people who have the baptism do not know what they have in the Holy spirit, and they don't let him work for them, that is why they stay down and out and live in pools of doubt, fear, frustration and despair, you heard that he was wonderful and great and that he was promised to us. In book of "acts 2:39" says for God's promise (of the Holy Spirit) was made to you and your children, and to all who are far away, all whom the Lord our God calls to himself, we never took our time to get to know the Spirit, and that is why many of God's people have been weak when they could have been strong, how sad it is to have the Holy Spirit, our teacher, our guide and helper living in us, yet not know when He is moving, we must know ourselves and know the difference between you and Holy Spirit, we must know when we are going into our own thinking, our own ways and our own opinions because at those times, we will limit the Spirit from working in our lives, however, when we gladly yield our mind and body to Him, they become His territory, we have given Him the power of control over us; and He is in the driver's seat of our lives, we also have to be aware of the unknown Spirits (evil) and the fact that we want our own way to take over, we must ask and wait on God before going our own way, some of us run ahead and make a lot of mess that the Holy Spirit has to try to clean up, you know what am talking about, the hour is now the holy Spirit will not continue to clean up messes for the children of God its time to open our mind and heart like never before, its time to walk in truth, knowing that we can ask God for anything and He will always come through for us, because of the Love that He has for us, there is no time for us to be lukewarm in this great outpouring of the Holy Spirit, there is no excuse for any member of the body of christ to be lukewarm, God despises lukewarmness, "Revelation 3:15,16" and surely you don't want to be anything that God despises.

The Holy Spirit cannot lead people who are full of self. That is why the Lord wants us to study ourself and know how and when we go into our own human thinking, our own ways, our own notions and our own opinions. When we depend on self, we hinder the Spirit from being able to work with us as He wants to, because our soul and mind are not completely open to Him. Then doubt, fear, ego, unbelief and so many other things that are not of God begin to creep in.

No matter what you are facing today God will give you great favor, peace and laughter;and the Holy Spirit is there to give you direction, like Paul, we must find God's grace to be sufficient, He told Paul, my grace is sufficient for thee; for my strength is made perfect in weakness, "Il Corinthians 12:9" My brothers and sisters, it doesn't matter how deep the valley is, how horrible the lions' den is or how hot the fiery furnace is, God will always be with you through Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit, our sufferings will not last forever and the Bible confirms that in "Romans 8:17-18" that since we are his children, we will possess the blessing he keeps for his people, and we will also posses with Christ what God has kept for him; for if we share Christ's suffering, we will also share his glory. that is so clear, so many wonderful blessings will be ours when we walk with the Lord.



Chapter Twelve

LET THE HOLY SPIRIT FLOW FREELY

How much do you depend on the Holy Spirit? Who is He to you; how do you treat Him, and what place does He have in your life? You cannot be in and out and up and down, and you can't live in your feelings if you want to please God, true disciples never live in their feelings; they live by faith and in all the wonders of divinity. God has our back always through Angels who cooperate with true children of God who live holy, and they cooperate in every one who does the work of God, they also hold back the powers of darkness on our behalf. When you are in the family of God, your body is a temple of God; and He walks inside of you. "Il Corinthians 6:16" says You are the temple of the living God; as God himself said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Paul knew this, and he said, in "Galatians 2:20" I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me.

Brothers and sisters we don't have much time left, we have to give over to the Spirit and move like we have never moved before. We have to be altar workers; we have to be prayer warriors, and we have to fast and seek the face of God. We have to listen to what the Spirit is saying rather than what people are saying. Don't count your own life brothers and sisters except for what it is worth to the Lord and what the Holy Spirit can use it for. we have to Let the Holy Spirit use our hands for anything He wants to, and we should keep our eyes holy so they will be able to see whatever the Holy Spirit wants them to. We must have a tongue of fire that will speak nothing but truth, and that truth will penetrate into the stony hearts of people throughout the world.

The Holy Spirit must be our prayer partner. "Romans 8:26" says in the same way the Spirit also comes to help us, weak as we are, for we do not know how we ought to pray; the Spirit himself pleads with God for us in groans that words cannot express. Nevertheless, some of us cannot seem to get anywhere in our prayer life because we don't know the Holy Spirit. If we really knew Him and knew that He dwelt on the inside of us, we would turn everything over to Him whenever we feel that we are not able to pray. The Holy Spirit will take up where we stop and then take us beyond and make intercession for us. "Romans 8:27" says, and God, who sees into our hearts, knows what the thought of the Spirit is; because the Spirit pleads with God on behalf of his people and in accordance with His will.

We cannot jump up and run away from the presence of God; we have to get quiet and let the Holy Spirit work with us. He will spend all the time with us that we want; but how many hours do we waste each week in which He could be edifying us with more truth, more love and more grace? The Lord said, Be still, and know that I am God "Psalm 46:10". The Holy Spirit came to help us to be still in His presence so He can teach us. His tender touch gives our spirit such peace that it gets quiet. Then He can get our mind's attention, take over in a miraculous way and do wonders. The holy spirit can be our inspiration, too. Some of us look to ourself or others for our inspiration, but human inspiration is weak; and it cannot perform miracles for us. However, the Holy Spirit serves us divine, eternal inspiration. Every word of the Bible was given through the divine inspiration of God. When the Holy Spirit speaks to us or prays through us, it is divine inspiration; but many of us don't realize it or recognize it, so we are not edified and blessed. The devil tricks us to keep us down in the dumps when we should be on the mountaintop. But even in the valley, we should have great joy; and we will, if we know the Holy Spirit is with us.

Brothers and sisters we have to learn how to yield to the Holy Spirit, If we yield to our own spirit and our own way, the Holy Spirit can never flow freely because we limit Him, and we will never yield to the Word of God like you should until we yield to the Holy Spirit, and that is why so many of us have a hard time understanding the Bible. we only yield to the letter of the Word, we read it the same way we read newspaper or a magazine; but that is not the way it should be. When we study the Word, we have to let the Holy Spirit feed us and direct us to the parts we really need. He knows what we need because He has all the wisdom and knowledge about us. He knows about our battles, our despair, our heartaches, our weaknesses, our strengths and our spiritual health; and since He has all of that knowledge and power, why are we afraid to give over to Him? we won't let Him encourage us; and instead, we listen to self and the devil, When we yield our whole self to the Holy Spirit, everything about us becomes His—our soul, our mind and our body, we have completely buried self, and we have given the Spirit the power of control over us. our spirit melts into His, and He takes over. our mind is His to think through and use; and that puts Him in the driver's seat of wisdom, knowledge and greatness.

The Holy Spirit will teach us more than any parent, earthly professor or instructor ever could; and He will give us more wisdom and knowledge day by day than we could ever gain in a lifetime. we don't have to make mistakes like we have done in the past because divinity knows what we should do in every situation. "Romans 8:28" says And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Its important also for us to know that The Holy Spirit came to glorify Jesus. In "John 16:12-15" the scripture says I have much more to tell you, but now it would be too much for you to bear, when however, the Spirit comes, who reveals the truth about God, he will lead you into all the truth, he will not speaks on his own authority, but he will speak of what he hears, and He will give me glory, because he will take what i say and tell it to you, all that my father has is mine; that is why I said that the Spirit will take what i give him and tell it to you. When the Spirit comes in and speaks through a person, He is usually glorifying Jesus.

The Holy Spirit will also show us what the Lord wants us to do and help us do it. The Lord has not left us on this Earth to fend for ourself, but when we try to do things on our own, we will rob ourself of divine peace and health and become flesh-minded rather than Holy Spiritminded. We have to acknowledge the Lord and His Spirit without running ahead of Him or lagging behind. That's why in "proverbs 3:5" the scripture says, Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct all thy paths. that's why we have to consult God in every move that we make, every step that take, before we want to buy Land or a house or some big item, we should get the mind of the Lord, lets say what you've bought was stolen do you know what kind of spirits that are attached to the thing that you've just bought? we always have to look to the Lord and wait on Him, he has all the answers we need. God is so patient with us, as hard as waiting is but we must also have patience to wait on Him. So let us yield to the Holy Spirit, so that He can bless us and bless others through us. we must allow the power of the Spirit to flow within us, but that will not happen unless we know Him and recognize well His divine flow is available to us, we must know when He speaks, when He moves and when He is dealing with us. Only then we will know whether we are yielding to Him or to our own spirit. We have to know when the Spirit is working, and it cannot be emotionalism; but that is all many churches have. There are no works of the Holy Spirit in their services, and the Holy Spirit is not recognized because the people are so busy with their own demonstrations of the flesh, Some people live like the devil, yet they go to church and sing with a lot of emotionalism. Then people who hear them and see them think that is the anointing of God; but it is not, and it fools many people, when we sing Godly songs from our heart, the Holy Spirit will join in and sweep us into the greatness of God; however, many people's praises are just human praises and their shouts are human shouts. They have cut off divinity, so divinity has nothing to do with their praises. Some of us will watch a minister on tv (television) and not know whether he has the spirit of God, the spirit of man or the spirit of the devil; but we must know.

When we are making melody unto the Lord, don't just sing words; we have to let the Holy Spirit help us to put your whole heart into it and really mean it. When we sing about the power in the blood of Jesus, we must experience what we are singing and realize that the divine blood gives us power over all demonic spirits, I am an artist i make music and I know exactly what i am talking about, and every song that I record I make sure that I fast before going to the studio to record, because when we fast we will blind the flesh and we are in the presence of God whether we want it or not. So we have to realize that the Holy Spirit wants us to depend on Him as our source of wisdom and knowledge; but some of us are always seeking human wisdom and knowledge, and that is why we don't have any from above, and then we wonder, "God, why did this happen?" It was because we did not let the Holy Spirit serve us what we needed. we looked to another source for our supply, and He will let us do that; but know that we will not have the divine joy, divine peace or any of the other things He supplies.

We have to know our way from a spiritual standpoint. In the natural, most people hate to walk on a strange path in the dark and not know where they are going; yet we will travel spiritual paths without knowing where our feet are going to land, we are not aware of the danger that may be ahead or the fact that we are not giving over to the Holy Spirit. How sad it is for Spirit-filled people not to know the Holy Spirit who lives on the inside of them. Some of us know our neighbors, friends and family members better than we know the Holy Spirit who lives within, brothers and sisters we have to become acquainted with the Holy Spirit. If we have the Holy Spirit, are we now anxious to get more acquainted with Him? We must want to get off to ourself and say, "Holy Spirit, I want to learn all about you. I want to know how to discern between my spirit and yours at all times, and I want to recognize the difference between when you are speaking and when I am speaking." Philip was alive with the fire of the Holy Spirit, and the Spirit was able to direct him to a eunuch in the desert. The eunuch was puzzled about the writings of Isaiah, and Philip was able to explain the Scriptures to him. The eunuch then accepted Christ and wanted to be baptized, "Acts 8:36-40" says as they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, look, here is water, what can stand in the way of my being baptized. Philip said, if you believe with all your heart, you may, the eunuch answered, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

After Philip had baptized the eunuch, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea. you see, Philip was so yielded to God that the Holy Spirit was able to pick him up out of the desert and set him down in another place that was about 100 miles away so he could preach the Gospel there. How did it happen? He was carried on the wings of the greatness of the fire of the Spirit Remember the Spirit teaches us to learn all about Jesus just as Jesus said we should. "Matthew 11:29" says Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

The Spirit seeks to make Jesus real to people, and I seek to know everything I can about Him; but there is so much to learn about Jesus that we will be in Heaven for trillions of years and still never know all about Him. Children of God must walk like Jesus, talk like Jesus and think like Jesus, Jesus could not be satisfied until He had accomplished His mission. Are you yielded to the point where you can say as Jesus did. "In Luke 22:42" Not my will, but yours, be done.

Some people will say God told them to do something; but the next day, they have a different story. When God really tells you something, it will burn upon your soul and in your innermost being. Paul knew what God wanted of him, and he always bowed to God's will. He felt the force of the Spirit leading him into the place God wanted him to be, "Acts 20:22-24" it says and now, in obedience to the Holy Spirit i am going to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there, I only know that in every city the Holy Spirit has warned me that prison and troubles wait for me, but I reckon my own life to be worth nothing to me; I only want to complete my mission and finish the work that the Lord Jesus gave me to do, which is to declare the good news about the grace of God, its clear that Paul did not let nothing deter him from what the Spirit directed him to do, Paul was completely yielded, and we can learn to be that yielded too.

Brothers and sisters remember to receive the baptism, after that we have to give the Holy Spirit the right-of-way in our life all the time; but how much of our life have we actually given to Him? Once we know the Spirit and give Him the right-of-way, He will take it; but He will never force us to give it to Him. we have to willingly give Him the right-of-way with our personality, our spirit and the whole us; and we are the only ones who can make that choice—no man can do it for us, and even God can't do it for us, obviously because of the free will that he gave us, so when we speak, we should give over to the Holy Spirit, yield to Him and get into his flow because all He wants is to speak through us and bless those who may be listening. so let the Holy Spirit flow freely through your tongue and anything that you will touch.

Oh, God, I don't want to be left. I have sinned against you, against Heaven and against the Holy Spirit. Please, Jehovah God, have mercy on my sinful soul! I want to be made pure, clean and holy. I believe your blood washes away all of my sins. Come into my heart, Jesus! Come on in!

If you meant that prayer, you can now say to the Lord. Thank you, I am free from all sin, I love your Son, Jesus, and I thank you for giving Him to me. One day, I will behold your face, dear God; and I will behold all of your glory. Until then, I will live holy and help bring in the lost.
